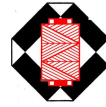

KK 100 - THE NO STAIN SPRAY ADHESIVE

When handled properly, **KK 100** will not stain even delicate fabrics.

However, if you should have any problems with stains, please proceed as follows:

- Spray in short bursts, especially if only small areas have to be sprayed. It is essential to keep a distance of 20-30 cm to the material. Already a small amount of spray adhesive will provide sufficient tack!
- For larger areas to be sprayed, please keep a spraying distance of 30 cm and move can back and forth while spraying in order to ensure an even dispersion of the spray adhesive.
- Place small parts next to each other to form a larger area and spray all of them in one go. This ensures an even dispersion on small parts as well.

If any stains occur due to incorrect handling, we recommend consulting a professional dry cleaner.

Since the glue is alcohol soluble, a specialist may determine the concentration of the cleaning agent, depending on the degree of staining.

Nevertheless, you may try to remove the stain yourself:

For a cheap cleaning agent, use denatured alcohol. Test the fabric to make sure the denatured alcohol will not damage or discolour the material

The following cleaning method is advisable:

- Place felt underneath stain
- Soak a piece of fabric (preferably of the same kind as the embroidered fabric) in denatured alcohol and rub stain.

Should there be any rings as a result from stain removal, rub rings again with soaked piece of fabric and dry fast using an iron. But please **do not place iron directly onto fabric**. Use it only as a heat source, circling above fabric in a short distance.
